WILL RECEIVE \$20 MILLION IN STIMULUS FUNDING FOR

**WASHINGTON -- Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that the Marine Corps Base Hawaii will receive \$19.36 million for a child development center. This funding is part of the military construction stimulus expenditure plan in conjunction with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.**

**Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka said: "This center will positively impact the mission of the servicemen and servicewomen assigned to Marine Corps Base Hawaii as many have families. The knowledge that their children are cared for in a facility with educational and training rooms means less family stress and increased work productivity. For their service and willingness to serve in harm's way, this is the least we can do for them."**
