**HAWAII TO RECEIVE \$15 MILLION IN STIMULUS FUNDING
FOR KAHULUI AIRPORT IMPROVEMENTS**

WASHINGTON --- Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that the State will receive \$15 million from the Department of Transportation to rehabilitate the apron pavement at the Kahului airport. This grant is funded under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

“The funding will go to improving the facilities at the Kahului airport, used for loading, unloading and maintaining aircraft,” said Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka. “The hard-working crews at Kahului get the job done, but these improvements will clean up routine wear and tear and, better support the operational demands for aircraft arriving and departing from Maui.”
