INOUYE, AKAKA ANNOUNCE MILITARY FACILITIES IN HAWAII TO RECEIVE \$184 MILLION IN STIMULUS FUNDING FOR RENOVATIONS

WASHINGTON -- Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that the State will receive \$184 million for facilities, sustainment, restoration and modernization projects in conjunction with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

“Military roads, bridges and wharfs will be repaired and upgraded,” said Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka. “The infrastructure improvements will also give a boost to our local economy.”
