HAWAII HEALTH CENTERS TO RECEIVE MORE THAN \$8.5 MILLION IN FEDERAL GRANTS

WASHINGTON --- Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that Hawaii health centers will receive \$8,550,050 in federal grants to address immediate and pressing facility and equipment needs and increase access to healthcare for Hawaii residents. These Recovery Act Capital Improvement Program grants support the construction, repair and renovation of health center sites and fund the purchase of new equipment or health information technology systems.

“These resources will strengthen the ability of our island health care providers to meet the increasing needs of our communities,” said Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka.
