STATE TO RECEIVE \$1.3 MILLION FOR HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IMPROVEMENTS

WASHINGTON --- Hawaii will receive more than \$1.3 million from the U.S. Department of Transportation for runway improvements at the Honolulu International Airport, Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye announced today.

The money will be used to repair cracking and spalling in Taxiway B, a runway measuring 6,000 feet by 50 feet that is utilized by domestic and international air carriers.

“Maintaining safe and timely air travel is critical for our residents, our visitors and the State’s economy,” said Chairman Inouye. “Repairing this runway now will prolong its useful life and save the state money in the long term.”
