**INOUE ANNOUNCES FEDERAL BUILDINGS
TO RECEIVE NEARLY \$137 MILLION IN STIMULUS FUNDING
FOR ENERGY IMPROVEMENTS**

WASHINGTON -- Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye announced today that the Prince Kuhio Kalaniana'ole Federal Building in Honolulu and the Federal Building in Hilo will receive nearly \$137 million from the U.S. General Services Administration for energy improvements. This funding is in conjunction with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

“This significant funding will allow our federal buildings to transform into high-performance green buildings,” said Chairman Inouye. “These projects will also create more jobs at such a crucial time in our economy.”

The funding is as follows:
