**THREE OAHU HARBORS TO RECEIVE \$5 MILLION
IN STIMULUS FUNDING FOR OPERATION, MAINTENANCE REPAIRS
FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

WASHINGTON -- U.S. Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that three harbors on Oahu will receive nearly \$5 million for operations and maintenance repairs.

Haleiwa Small Boat Harbor (\$3.1 million) and Waianae Small Boat Harbor (\$1.5 million) will receive funds for maintenance dredging to their entrance channels.

With 50,000 visitors annually, Barbers Point Harbor will receive \$348,000 to upgrade its visitor center exhibits, replace its air conditioner system, and renovate its restrooms. These Civil Works projects will be funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

“Keeping our harbors safe, operational and accessible has always been a major priority for us,” said Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka. “The funds will ensure that these harbors are functioning efficiently and safely for all users.”
