## **CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU RECEIVES \$1 MILLION FEDERAL GRANT TO AID YOUNG PARENTS**

**WASHINGTON ---United States Senator Daniel K. Inouye announced today that the City and County of Honolulu will receive a \$1 million grant from the U.S. Department of Labor to help underprivileged young parents obtain education and occupational skills training that lead to employment.**

**The grant will allow mothers, expectant mothers, and fathers ages 16 to 24 to receive training that will help provide a better future for themselves and their children. Support services, which include child care, transportation and health care, will also be available to participating young parents.”**

**“The initiatives funded by this grant will give parents whose young lives have already been challenged by homelessness, abuse or separation from their own parents a chance for a brighter future,” said Senator Inouye. “The programs represent the crucial first step toward a stable life with financial stability for themselves and their children.”**
