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INOUE, AKAKA ANNOUNCE NEARLY \$60 MILLION IN STIMULUS FUNDS WILL BE USED FOR ARMY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN HAWAII

Complete List of Project Funding Released

WASHINGTON --- U.S. Senate Appropriations Chairman Daniel K. Inouye and Senator Daniel K. Akaka announced today that the Department of Defense will use nearly \$60 million on job-creating construction projects at Schofield Barracks, Wheeler Army Airfield and Fort Shafter on Oahu and Bradshaw Army Airfield and Pohakuloa Training Area on the Big Island through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

“As veterans and as lawmakers sensitive to the needs of our Armed Forces and the needs of Hawaii, particularly during these tough economic times, we are pleased to announce this round of stimulus funding,” said Chairman Inouye and Senator Akaka. “This stimulus funding will create numerous construction industry jobs that will boost Hawaii’s economy during this difficult time, while repairing and improving facilities our troops use to train before their deployments. These projects will also increase the use of clean, renewable energy on base, and develop services for the children and families of servicemembers.”

In addition to chairing the full Senate Appropriations Committee, Senator Inouye has for years been the top Democrat on the Senate defense appropriations

subcommittee, serving as either chairman or ranking member. Senator Akaka serves as the head of the Senate Committee on Veterans' Affairs.
